SPECIAL, OUTSIDE SERVICES: These are optional & available at additional costs.

- Other classes such as ballet, gymnastics, language lessons, etc. may also be offered on campus after 1:00 pm.

SCHOOL ENROLLMENT:

- Enrollment is based on your child's age on Sept. 1st
- We will need a copy of your child's birth certificate on file
- A certificate of immunization on a state form is due within 30 days of admission
- Enrollment is 1st come, 1st serve, available to church and current families first before being opened to the community

MULTIPLE CHILD DISCOUNT

Tuition will be discounted 5% for each additional sibling enrolled.

TUITION

Tuition is charged on an annual basis; if you are not paying in full, you are given the option of making 10 equal monthly payments beginning in June 2008 and ending in March 2009. Tuition is always due on the 1st day of the month and is non-refundable;

PHILOSOPHY:

***Children:** Are gifts from God (Psalm 127:3) and He has gifted each one in different ways (1 Corinthians 14-31). We believe that children develop at their own pace, that they learn in many different ways, and that they express giftedness in different, and sometimes multiple, areas of development. We believe that a child's spiritual, social, emotional, physical, and intellectual development are all significant areas which need to be closely related during instruction.

***Teachers:** Are to model Christ's love (Luke 6:40); are to provide instruction and guidance with encouragement and enthusiasm.

***Parents:** Are to be the main source of spiritual nurture for their children (Deuteronomy 6:6-9), working with the church and school for assistance and guidance.

***School:** A medium for transferring a way of life to students based on biblical truths. (Proverbs 22:6)

MISSION:

***Sharing Christ:** We seek daily to serve God's children and their families by sharing Jesus in a loving, safe, and stimulating Christian environment.

***Developmentally Appropriate Christian Training:** We strive to provide a Christian foundation for children including exposure to chapel time, bible stories, verses, songs, and prayer. At our school, children learn through play and free exploration experiences as well as during more structured activities designed

for their stage of development. Learning is viewed as an active process that is natural and joyful for the child. Throughout our day, we incorporate the use of student choice with activities that are hands-on and multi-sensory in nature.

Additional benefits for your child based on our Christian philosophy and mission:

- A sense of self-worth based on the knowledge that we were created by God and in His image (Genesis 1:27)
- Opportunities to be successful daily that give a positive introduction to school
- On-going experiences that expand your child's knowledge of him/ herself and the world around him/her

- Growth in creativity
- Language experiences through everyday activities that develop eagerness for reading when your child is ready
